**PROCLAMATION**

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Basutoland Personal and Savings Fund Levy Repeal (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Basutoland Personal and Savings Fund Levy Repeal Proclamation, 1946, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the principal law is here-  
by amended by adding at the end thereof the  
following proviso:—

“ Provided that notwithstanding the  
provisions of section *seventeen* of the said  
Proclamation such levy savings may be  
refunded by the Collector at any time after  
the publication of this Proclamation in the  
*Gazette* upon the written application of any  
person to whose credit any amount of levy  
savings stands in the Personal and Savings  
Fund Loan Account.”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the  
Basutoland Personal and Savings Fund Levy  
Repeal (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
