PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Swaziland Motor Vehicle (Amendment)
Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to increase the annual licence fees charged in respect of motor vehicles in Swaziland and for that purpose further to amend the Motor Vehicle (Swaziland) Proclamation, 1916, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers, authorities and jurisdiction conferred upon and committed to me by His Majesty under the Swaziland Order in Council, 1903, as amended by the Swaziland Order in Council, 1906, and the Swaziland Order in Council, 1909, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (6) of section *two* of the principal law, as amended by Proclamation No. 14 of 1930, is hereby further amended as follows:—

(1) by deleting the figures "£1 0 0" in paragraph (a) thereof and substituting therefor the figures "£1 2 6";

(2) by deleting the figures "£2 0 0" in paragraph (c) (1) thereof and substituting therefor the figures "£2 10 0".

2. This proclamation may be cited as the Swaziland Motor Vehicle (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of January, 1948.
