PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner
Entitled the Swaziland Motor Vehicle Insurance
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Swaziland Motor Vehicle Insurance Proclamation, 1946, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers, authorities and jurisdiction conferred upon and committed to me by His Majesty under the Swaziland Order in Council, 1903, as amended by the Swaziland Order in Council, 1903, and the Swaziland Order in Council, 1906 I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The following section, numbered *five A*, New section 5A of Proclamation No. 19 of 1946. is hereby inserted immediately after section *five* of the principal law:—

Stamp duty.

"5A. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the law relating to stamp duties, the stamp duty on every declaration of insurance issued in terms of section *three* or section *five* of this Proclamation shall be one shilling."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Short title and commencement. Swaziland Motor Vehicle Insurance (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947, and shall be deemed to have had force and effect as from the sixteenth day of August, 1946.
