

# BASUTOLAND.

No. 43 of 1947.

(Promulgated 25th July, 1947.)

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner  
Entitled the Basutoland Appropriation (1947-48)  
Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to make provision out of the public revenue or other funds of Basutoland for the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1948:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of Basutoland are hereby charged towards the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1948, with the sum of £902,005 (nine hundred and two thousand and five pounds). Public revenue charged with £902,005.

2. The moneys granted by this Proclamation shall be applied to the purposes and services set forth in the Schedule annexed hereto and more particularly specified in the Estimates of Expenditure of Basutoland for the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1948, submitted to and approved by the Secretary of State for Dominion Affairs. Purposes for which moneys to be applied.

3. The moneys granted by this Proclamation shall not be issued or applied to any use, intent or purpose other than the particular services to which the said amounts have been granted respectively by this Proclamation. Moneys not to be used for other purposes.

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Basutoland Appropriation (1947-48) Proclamation, 1947, and shall be deemed to have had force and effect as from the first day of April, 1947. Short title and commencement.
