PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Basutoland Further Appropriation
(1945-1946) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is desirable to make further provision out of the public revenue or other funds of Basutoland to meet certain additional expenditure incurred during the year which ended the 31st day of March, 1946.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of Basutoland are hereby charged with a further sum of £30,813. 15s. 6d. (thirty thousand eight hundred and thirteen pounds fifteen shillings and sixpence) to meet expenditure incurred during the year ended 31st March, 1946, in excess of the amounts appropriated for that purpose according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule to this Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the short title, Basutoland Further Appropriation (1945-1946) Proclamation, 1947.
