PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate External
Agents (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate External Agents Proclamation, 1940 (hereinafter styled the "Principal Law");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (1) of section *two* of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted in lieu thereof:—

Amendment of Section (2) of Proclamation No. 33 of 1940.

“ Every External Agent shall be required to take out a licence expiring on the 31st day of December next following the date of issue, and there shall be paid for such licence the sum of twenty-five pounds in respect of each calendar year or twelve pounds ten shillings in respect of a licence taken out after 30th June.”

2. The Bechuanaland Protectorate External Agents (Amendment) Proclamation, 1940 (Number 59 of 1940), is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Proclamation No. 59 of 1940.

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate External Agents (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of July, 1947.

Short title and commencement.
