PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs
(Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *seventy-two* of the principal law is hereby amended by the insertion of the following new sub-section immediately after sub-section (2):—

"(3) A rebate of the whole of the duty shall be allowed in respect of fortified wine imported or taken out of bond for use in any church for religious purposes."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the short title. Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs (Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
