

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 10 OF 1948.

It is hereby notified for general information that, by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *nine* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police Proclamation, 1937 (No. 69 of 1937), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police General Regulations, which were published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 212 of 1937, in the following respects:—

Regulation 11 shall be and is hereby cancelled and the following regulation substituted in lieu thereof:—

11. The term of engagement for Native Police will be for two years, with the option of subsequent re-engagement biennially for similar periods of two years, if approved by the Commissioner, and subject to such option being exercised at least two months before the expiration of the current contract.
