

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE.

No. 144 of 1948.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by Section *nine* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police Proclamation 1937 (No. 69 of 1937), as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police Regulation, published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 212 of 1937, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 227 of 1947, as follows:—

1. Regulation 8 is amended by deleting the word "Commissioner" where it occurs for the second time in the fifth line and substituting therefor the words "Resident Commissioner".

2. Regulations 10, 16, 44 and 45 are amended by deleting the word "Commissioner" wherever it occurs and substituting therefor the words "Resident Commissioner".

3. Regulation 14 is cancelled and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

"Quarters will be provided free but married quarters will not be provided for subordinate officers or Junior Sub-Inspectors who have married without first having obtained the permission of the Resident Commissioner."

4. Regulation 19 is amended by deletion of the words "by the Resident Commissioner in accordance *mutatis mutandis* with such procedure as may be prescribed in any regulation made under Proclamation No. 32 of 1924" and the substitution therefor of the words "in accordance with Colonial Regulations".

5. Regulation 20 is amended by the insertion after the word "may" in the second line of the words "with prior approval of the Resident Commissioner".

6. Regulation 26 (3) is amended by deleting the words "Police Cadets" in the first line and inserting therefor the words "Junior Sub-Inspectors".

7. Regulation 27 is amended by the insertion after the word "may" in the eighth line of the words "with the prior approval of the Resident Commissioner".

8. Regulation 31 is amended by the insertion after the word " may " in the ninth line of the words " with the prior approval of the Resident Commissioner " .

9. Regulation 32 is amended by the substitution for the words " subordinate officer " in the eighth line of the words " senior inspector, inspector, warrant officer, non-commissioned officer or trooper " .

10. Regulation 35 is amended by the insertion after the word " may " in the first line of the words " with the prior approval of the Resident Commissioner " and the substitution of the words " Resident Commissioner " for the word " Commissioner " where it occurs in the second proviso to the Regulation.
