HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 145 of 1948.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of sub-sections (2) of sections *seventy two* of the Basutoland, Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland Customs Proclamations (Nos. 46, 51 and 49 of 1944 respectively) His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to approve the following amendment to part X of the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of 1945.

Paragraph 1 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

1. A rebate or refund of the whole duty shall be allowed on material for hospital nurses' uniforms imported by or on behalf of any public hospital and on appointments and material for uniforms by or on behalf of—

- (a) the St. John's Ambulance Association;
- (b) the South African Red Cross Society;
- (c) the Boy Scouts' or Girl Guides' Association.
- (d) the Boys' Brigade;
- (e) the Girls' Life Brigade;

on production of a certificate signed by the Government Secretary in respect of such hospitals or by the Secretary of such Brigade or Officer in Charge of such Association or Brigade as the case may be, that the material is intended solely for the manufacture of nurses' uniforms for hospital use, or of uniforms for the use of members of such Association or Brigade or that the appointments are intended solely for the use of such members as the case may be, and on an understanding that if any of the said material or appointments are sold or otherwise used or disposed of, the duty rebated or refunded thereon will forthwith be paid to the Director.
