HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 149 of 1948.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of sub-sections (2) of sections *seventy-two* of the Basutoland, Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland Customs Proclamations (Nos. 46, 51 and 49 of 1944, respectively), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of 1945 as follows:—

(1) By the addition to paragraph 1 of Part III of the Schedule of the following:—

(13) *Plastic Goods Manufacturing Industry.*—Thermoplastic materials in bars, blocks, rods, sheets, slabs and tubes and raw castings (straight from the lead mould without any further processing) made from thermoplastic or thermosetting plastic moulding materials.

(14) *Bag-making Industry.*—Wrapping paper (plain) for use in the manufacture of bags consisting of cotton and paper.

(15) *Broom and Brush-making Industry.*—Plastic or synthetic monofilaments.

(16) *Cattle and Poultry Foods Manufacturing Industry.*—Molasses in such quantities and at such times as may be permitted by the High Commissioner.

(17) *Benzene Hexachloride Concentrate Manufacturing Industry.*—Benzol.

(18) *Ice-Cream Cup Manufacturing Industry.*—Bleached draft paper (plain).

(19) *Pipe (Tobacco) Manufacturing Industry.*—Rims and bands of metal (other than precious metal) and ebonite rods.

(20) *Fish Oil Refining and Concentrating Industry.*—Raw fish oil (including whale liver oil) for refining and concentration in the Territories, in such quantities and at such times as may be permitted by the High Commissioner.

(21) *Binding Manufacturing Industry.*—Materials in the piece for the manufacture of trouser bands and collar and cuff canvases, for supply to manufacturers and to wholesalers.

(22) *Electric Cable Manufacturing Industry.*—
Thermoplastic material in granular strip or slab
form.

(2) (a) By the insertion in paragraph 2 of Part VI of the Schedule after the word “rebate” and the word “cases” where the latter word appears for the second time, of the words “and tins constructed from materials imported under rebate” and “or tins” respectively.

(b) By the insertion in paragraph 3 of Part VI of the Schedule after the word “cases” of the words “or tins”.

(c) By the insertion in paragraph 4 of Part VI of the Schedule after the word “cases” of the words “or tins”.

NOTE.—The general effect of this Notice is to allow a rebate of the whole duty on the above-mentioned materials when imported or taken out of bond by registered manufacturers for use in the specified industries.
