

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 196 of 1948.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to define the area mentioned hereunder within which Royal Game, Large Game and Small Game, as specified in the First, Second and Third Schedules to the said Proclamation, shall be protected for a period of three years from the 1st September, 1948.

Provided that it shall be lawful for the Resident Commissioner to authorise the District Commissioner at Lobatsi to issue permits to natives residing within the said area to hunt therein and kill game in reasonable quantities for food:—

AREA.

The Crown lands north of the Molopo River within the Lobatsi District, as defined in section 8 of High Commissioner's Notice No. 119 of 1923.
