HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 268 OF 1948.

APPLICATION OF MINIMUM, INTERMEDIATE  
AND MAXIMUM RATES OF DUTY IN TERMS  
OF THE BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE  
CUSTOMS PROCLAMATION, No. 51 OF 1944.—  
AMENDMENT OF HIGH COMMISSIONER'S  
NOTICE No. 4 OF THE 6TH JANUARY, 1945.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *forty-four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, No. 51 of 1944, His Excellency the High Commissioner has approved of the amendment of High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of the 6th January, 1945, as follows:—

(a) Delete paragraph (1).

(b) Add with effect from the 15th June, 1948, the following territories under paragraph (2):—

The Republic of China.

The Republic of Cuba.

The United States of America.

(c) Add with effect from the 29th July, 1948, the following territories under paragraph (2):—

Ceylon.

Lebanon.

(d) Add with effect from the 30th July, 1948, the following territories under paragraph (2):—

New Zealand.

Syria.

(e) Substitute under paragraph (2) under "Territories"—

(i) "Grand-Duchy of Luxemburg" for "Luxemburg".

(ii) "The Czechoslovak Republic" for "Czechoslovakia".

(iii) "Canada" for "The Dominion of Canada".

(iv) "The United States of Brazil" for "Brazil".

(v) "The Kingdom of Norway" for "Norway".

(f) Delete the words "Trans-Jordan" where it appears as a mandated territory of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

(g) Add the territory " Trans-Jordan ".

NOTE.—The effect of this notice is—

(a) that newsprint manufactured in Newfoundland is subject to the intermediate rate of duty;

(b) that the maximum rates of duty do not apply to the goods produced or manufactured in the additional territories; and

(c) to show the correct names of certain territories.
