

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 36 of 1948.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 54 of 1930 in the following respects:—

(a) Regulation 7 (f) (1).—Add the following:—

Provided that where such native patient requests European diet he shall be charged 12s. 6d. per diem in a private ward (when available) and 7s. 6d. per diem in a general ward.

(b) Regulation 7 (f) (2).—Increase the fee from 1s. 6d. per diem to 2s. 6d. per diem.

(c) Regulation 7 (f) (3).—Increase the fee from 12s. 6d. per diem to 17s. 6d. per diem.

(d) Regulation 7 (f) (4).—Increase the fee from 15s. per diem to 20s. per diem.

(e) Regulation 7 (f) (6).—Increase the fee from £1 to £1. 10s. for major operations and from 10s. to 15s. for minor operations.

(f) Add new sub-section to Regulation 7 (f) to read as follows:—

(10) Coloured in-patients resident in the Bechuanaland Protectorate shall be charged 5s. per diem and such charges as the medical officer may make for medical or surgical treatment and appliances referred to in paragraph (1). Coloured in-patients non-resident in the Protectorate shall be charged 7s. 6d. per diem and such fees as the medical officer shall charge for his services.

Provided that where such coloured patient requests European diet he shall be charged 15s. per diem in a private ward (when available) and 10s. per diem in a general ward.
