REGULATION.

10. Anything in Regulation No. 7 notwithstanding every person shall be entitled upon giving 24 hours notice to the Registrar and upon payment of the fees set forth in the Second Schedule hereto to search the index to and inspect any entry in any birth register or return in the custody of the Registrar, and on payment of a fee of five shillings be entitled to obtain from the Registrar a certified copy under the hand of that officer of any such entry provided, however, that such certified copy shall not include any particulars except the name, surname, sex and date, place and time of birth, not being particulars relating to parentage or adoption.
