HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 66 OF 1948.

FEEES AND CHARGES FOR USE OF GOVERN-  
MENT PROPERTY.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 169 of 1944, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 84 of 1946 by the cancellation of paragraph 4 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following new paragraph:—

4. Grazing and watering fees in respect of cattle:—

(a) Where grazing and watering are provided by Government, a maximum charge of 2s. 6d. per head per month or part of a month in the discretion of the Resident Commissioner shall be charged.

(b) Where grazing only is provided a maximum charge of 2s. per head per month or part of a month in the discretion of the Resident Commissioner shall be charged.

It is to be understood that grazing and water will only be hired when available.
