**PROCLAMATION**

**By His Excellency the High Commissioner**  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Licensing of  
Insurance Agents (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Licensing of Insurance Agents Proclamation, 1934 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal law").

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the figure "£5" wherever it occurs and the substitution therefor of the figure "£10".

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Licensing of Insurance Agents (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948, and shall be deemed to have had force and take effect from the first day of January, 1948.
