PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Immigration
Regulation (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to further amend the Immigration Regulation (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1932 (No. 34 of 1932), hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* sub-section (8) is hereby amended by inserting the following words between the words "written" and "notice" which occur in the penultimate line of the last paragraph, "or telegraphic".

2. Section *two* of the principal law is hereby further amended by the addition of the following sub-section—

"(9) Any person whose presence in the Territory is deemed by the Resident Commissioner to be or likely to be prejudicial to the peace, order and good government of the Territory or the interest of the natives living therein".

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the short title.
