

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

No. 2 of 1948.

(Promulgated 23rd January, 1948.)

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game  
(Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), as amended, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *eight* of the principal law, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following new section substituted therefor:—

"Subject to the provisions herein contained defining the close season and to the other provisions of this Proclamation the Resident Commissioner may issue licences upon such conditions as he may deem expedient to any person authorising such person to hunt game for the period specified therein. Such licences shall not be transferable and the following fees shall be chargeable therefor:—

A licence to hunt large game shall be deemed to authorise the licensee to hunt small game also.

For the purpose of this section "resident" shall mean any person who in the opinion of the Resident Commissioner is a bona fide resident, including the persons referred to in sub-section (3) of section *one* of Proclamation No. 58 of 1935, but excluding the persons referred to in section *two* of the said Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game (Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.
