PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Auction Dues
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend Act No. 5 of 1858 of the Cape of Good Hope (hereinafter referred to as "the principal law") in force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate by virtue of Proclamation No. 36 of 1909.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso:—

“ Provided that where the Resident Commissioner is satisfied that a sale by auction is being or has been conducted solely for the disposal of stock the property of natives residing in the Territory, he may waive the auction dues prescribed by this section.”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Auction Dues (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948, and shall have force and take effect as from the first day of January, 1947.
