

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical,  
Dental and Pharmacy (Amendment) Proclamation,  
1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical, Dental and Pharmacy Proclamation, 1934, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *six* of the Principal Law as amended by section *three* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical, Dental and Pharmacy (Amendment) Proclamation, 1945 (No. 7 of 1945), is hereby further amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following proviso:—

“ Provided that the Director of Medical Services may endorse upon the Certificate of Registration of any Oculist or Optician such conditions as he may consider necessary in the interests of the public.

The holder of a Certificate of Registration who fails to practise in accordance with the conditions endorsed upon such certificate may, on the written advice of the Director of Medical Services, have his name removed from the Register of Oculists and Opticians by order of the Resident Commissioner.”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical, Dental and Pharmacy (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.
