PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), hereinafter referred to as the "principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *twenty-five* of the principal law is hereby repealed and the following new section substituted therefor:—

" 25. The Chief of any tribe may grant permission to any native to hunt game within such Chief's tribal area and any such native may sell or barter within the Territory game so hunted.

Any native found hunting without the permission of the Chief of such tribal area shall be guilty of an offence against this Proclamation."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
