PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Pounds and
Trespasses (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Pounds and Trespasses Proclamation, 1925 (No. 12 of 1925), hereinafter referred to as the "principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The definition of Police Officer in section *two* of the principal law is hereby amended to read:—

“ Police Officer ” Superintendents, Assistant Superintendents, Inspectors and Subinspectors.

Amendment of section 2 of Proclamation No. 12 of 1925.

2. Section *four* of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting the word “ non-commissioned ” in line two and by substituting therefor the word “ subordinate ”.

Amendment of section 4 of Proclamation No. 12 of 1925.

3. Section *sixty-three* of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting the word “ non-commissioned ” in line one and by substituting therefor the word “ subordinate ”.

Amendment of section 63 of Proclamation No. 12 of 1925.

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Pounds and Trespasses (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.
