PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate European
Advisory Council (Amendment) Proclamation, 1948.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate European Advisory Council Proclamation, 1947 (hereinafter styled "Principal Law");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (1) of section *two* of the Principal Law shall be and is hereby amended by substituting the word "eight" for the word "seven".

Amendment of Proclamation No. 44 of 1947, Section 2 (1).

2. Sub-section (1) of section *three* of the Principal Law shall be and is hereby amended in the following respects:—

Amendment of Proclamation No. 44 of 1947, Section 3.

(a) The word "eight" shall be substituted for the word "seven".

(b) Paragraph (a) is amended by adding the following words "excluding Chobe District".

(c) The words "and Batawana Reserves" in paragraph (d) are hereby deleted and the word "Reserve" substituted in lieu thereof.

(d) A new paragraph (h) shall be inserted reading—

"(h) Batawana Reserve and Chobe District."

3. Section *nine* of the Principal Law shall be and is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "January, 1946" for the words "January, 1945".

Amendment of Proclamation No. 44 of 1947, Section 9.

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate European Advisory Council (Amendment) Proclamation of 1948, and shall have force and effect as from its date of publication in the *Gazette*.
