

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

No. 9 of 1948.

(Promulgated 12th March, 1948.)

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Insurance  
Companies Exemptions Proclamation, 1948

Whereas it is deemed expedient to exempt any Insurance Company engaged solely in the business of Compulsory Third Party Insurance of Motor Vehicles from the necessity of taking out a Licence and to grant certain other exemptions;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in section *eleven* of Act No. 38 of 1887 (Cape of Good Hope) in force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate by virtue of Proclamation No. 14 of 1897 the provisions of that section shall not apply to any Insurance Company engaged solely in the business of Compulsory Third Party Insurance of Motor Vehicles under Proclamation No. 18 of 1946.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in sub-section (c) of section *two* of Proclamation No. 14 of 1897 the provisions of that sub-section shall not apply to any Insurance Company engaged solely in the business of Compulsory Third Party Insurance of Motor Vehicles under Proclamation No. 18 of 1946.

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in section *one* of Proclamation No. 41 of 1934 the provisions of that Section shall not apply to any Insurance Company engaged solely in the business of Compulsory Third Party Insurance of Motor Vehicles under Proclamation No. 18 of 1946, or the Agent of any such Insurance Company, who carries on no other class of Insurance business.
