

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 160 OF 1949.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Prisons Proclamation, 1939 (No. 10 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following amendment to regulation 161 of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Prisons Regulations published in High Commissioner's Notice No. 45 of 1939:—

All the words after the words "and in addition" in the sixth line of regulation 161 are hereby repealed and the following words substituted: "to assist him with a third-class rail warrant or road warrant to the nearest station to it. No such warrant shall be issued for a journey of under ten miles."
