PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trade Unions
and Trade Disputes (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.

Whereas it is desirable to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Proclamation, 1942 (No. 16 of 1942), hereinafter referred to as "the principal law": *Cap 124 Vol II*

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section ~~sixteen~~¹⁷ of the principal law is hereby amended—

(a) by the deletion of the definition of the words "to intimidate";

and

(b) by the deletion of the definition of the word "injury".

2. Section ~~twenty~~²¹ of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-section (2) thereof.

3. Section ~~twenty-one~~²² of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-section (2) thereof.

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trade Unions and Trade Disputes (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.
