PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Proclamation, 1947, hereinafter called the "principal law":

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of the definition of the words "outside territory" and the substitution therefor of the following:—

Amendment of section 1 of Proclamation 23 of 1947.

" 'outside territory' includes the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Northern Rhodesia, Southern Rhodesia, Nyasaland, Swaziland, Basutoland and any other territory notified by the High Commissioner in the *Gazette*."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.
