PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Credit Sales to Natives (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.

Whereas it is deemed expedient to further amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Credit Sales to Natives Proclamation, 1932 (No. 35 of 1932), hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The following new section is hereby ^{New section 5B.} inserted immediately after section 5 A of the principal law:—

5. (B) Nothing in this Proclamation shall apply to the sale of any goods on credit to a Native, who, at the date of the purchase by him of such goods, was the holder of a current General Dealer's Licence.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the ^{Short title and commencement.} Bechuanaland Protectorate Credit Sales to Natives (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
