PROCLAMATION

By HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Mines and
Minerals (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Mines and Minerals Proclamation, 1932 (No. 33 of 1932), (hereinafter referred to as the principal law);

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the principal law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By inserting immediately after subsection (1) (*cc*) the following additional definition:—

(*dd*) “ Government Geologist ” means the person appointed as such by the High Commissioner.

2. Section *sixty-seven* of the principal law is hereby amended by the insertion of the words “ and Government Geologist ” immediately after the words “ Mining Commissioner ” in the third line.

3. Section *eighty* of the principal law is hereby amended by the insertion of the words “ or Government Geologist ” after the words “ Mining Commissioner ” where they appear in lines two and three.

4. Section *eighty-six* of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of the word “ or ” in the second line and by the insertion of the following words “ or Government Geologist ” immediately after the words “ Assistant Mining Commissioner ” in the second line thereof.

Short Title. 5. This Proclamation may be cited as the
Bechuanaland Protectorate Mines and
Minerals (Amendment) Proclamation, 1949.
