

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 123 OF 1950.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the importation of maize and maize products:—

1. Applications for permits to import maize and maize products into the Bechuanaland Protectorate must be addressed to the Controller and no maize or maize products must be imported except under the authority of a permit issued or endorsed by the Controller.

2. The Controller may require any person importing maize and maize products from the Union of South Africa to pay the sum of 4s. 2d. per unit of 200 lb. nett weight or such other sum as may hereafter be fixed by the Controller.

3. In the above regulations "Controller" means the Director of Agriculture or such other officer as may be appointed by him.

4. High Commissioner's Notices Nos. 179 and 234 of 1947 are hereby cancelled.
