

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 180 OF 1950.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to define the areas mentioned hereunder within which Royal Game, Large Game and Small Game, as specified in the First, Second and Third Schedules to the said Proclamation, shall be protected for a period of three years from the date of publication of this Notice.

Provided that it shall be lawful for the Resident Commissioner to authorise the District Commissioners at Ghanzi and Tshabong to issue permits to natives residing within the said areas in their respective districts to hunt therein and kill game in reasonable quantities for food.

AREAS.

(a) That portion of the Ghanzi District which lies to the west of the 21st meridian of east longitude and south of latitude 22° 30'.

(b) That portion of the Kgalagadi District not declared a Game Reserve.
