

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 46 OF 1950.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926 (No. 4 of 1926), and by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation of Cattle (Amendment) Proclamation, 1930 (No. 3 of 1930), as amended by Proclamation No. 43 of 1938, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel Regulation 4, published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 156 of 1938 and to substitute the following new Regulation therefor:—

“4. In respect of any inspection of small stock made under Regulation 94 of High Commissioner's Notice No. 80 of 1926 (as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 67 of 1932) and of any weighing, over weighbridges provided for that purpose, under Regulation 1 of High Commissioner's Notice No. 11 of 1930 and of any trucking under Regulation 2 of High Commissioner's Notice No. 11 of 1930 or of any other veterinary service or requirement provided for by Regulation, there shall be charged an inclusive fee of six pence for each head of small stock, which shall be payable by the intending exporter of such small stock before the small stock leave the place of inspection. For the purpose of this Regulation “exporter” means any person or body of persons whether corporate or incorporate who or which exports small stock from the Territory on his or its own behalf or on whose behalf any person exports small stock from the Territory.”

This Notice shall have force and effect from the first day of April, 1950.
