HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 82 OF 1950.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon the Council by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section *four* of the Basutoland Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 14 of 1945), paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 15 of 1945), and paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section *four* of the Swaziland Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 16 of 1945), the Council has prescribed the following qualifications required for registration of a nurse or midwife under the High Commission Territories Nursing Council:—

- (a) Nurses who have passed the final examination after training at a centre approved by the Council.
- (b) Nurses who are registered under the Medical, Dental and Pharmacy Act of the Union of South Africa.
- (c) Nurses who are registered in the British Nurses and Midwives' register.
- (d) Nurses who hold such other qualifications as may be approved by the Council from time to time.
