It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon the Council by sub-section (1) of section *four* of the Basutoland Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 14 of 1945), by sub-section (1) of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 15 of 1945), and by sub-section (1) of section *four* of the Swaziland Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 16 of 1945), the Council has prescribed the following fees to be paid to Government in respect of registration and examination of nurses and midwives as from the first day of January, 1951:—
