

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 9th June, 1950.)

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives (Amendment) Proclamation, 1950.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945 (No. 15 of 1945) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal law");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

#### Amendment of Section 10 of Proclamation No. 15 of 1945.

1. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of sub-section (3) of section *ten* of the principal law are hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

- “(a) to appoint examiners and to conduct examinations of local pupil nurses and midwives; and  
(b) to report the results of such examinations to the Council and to make recommendations for the enrolment of successful candidates for practice in the High Commission Territories.”

#### Amendment of Section 12 of Proclamation No. 15 of 1945.

2. Sub-sections (1) and (2) of section *twelve* of the principal law are hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“(1) The Council shall keep a register of nurses and of midwives resident in the Bechuanaland Protectorate who are qualified for registration under this Proclamation.

(2) Every person registered as a nurse or midwife shall pay to the Government the fee prescribed under paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) of section *four* of this Proclamation for registration and for re-registration.”

#### Short Title.

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives (Amendment) Proclamation, 1950.
