PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax
(Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1950.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation (Chapter 73 of the Laws of the Bechuanaland Protectorate), as amended (hereinafter styled "the principal law");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

Amendment of Section 7 of Chapter 73.

1. Section *seven* of the principal law, as amended, is hereby further amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) as inserted by the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax (Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1950 (No. 64 of 1950) of the following:—

~~"(a) Public companies as defined in sub-section (2) of section sixteen, the sum of forty-five pounds."~~

Repeal of Section 18 of Chapter 73.

2. Section *eighteen* of the principal law, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

~~"18. For the purposes of this Proclamation, the expression 'income subject to Super Tax' means an amount as determined in section twenty-one received by or accrued to or in favour of any person other than a public company."~~

Short Title and Commencement.

3. This Proclamation shall be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax (Further Amendment) Proclamation, 1950, and shall be deemed to have first commenced and come into operation in respect of assessments for the year of assessment ended upon the thirtieth day of June, 1950.
