**A LAW TO AUTHORISE THE PAYMENT OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF A SUM OF MONEY FOR THE SERVICES OF THE YEAR ENDING ON THE 31ST OF MARCH, 1967.**

(1st April, 1966)

ENACTED by the Legislature of Bechuanaland.

**Short Title.**

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation (1966/1967) Law, 1966.

**Expenditure of R9,404,175 Authorised.**

2. The Minister of Finance may issue a warrant for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund for the services of Bechuanaland during the year ending on the 31st day of March, 1967, of the sum of nine million, four hundred and four thousand, one hundred and seventy-five rand.

**Appropriation Thereof.**

3. The sum authorised by this Law shall be appropriated and applied to the services set out in the Schedule in the amounts set opposite thereto.
