A LAW TO MAKE FINAL PROVISION OUT OF THE PUBLIC FUNDS OF BECHUANALAND TO MEET CERTAIN EXPENDITURE INCURRED DURING THE YEAR ENDING THE 31ST MARCH, 1965.

(11th June, 1966)

ENACTED by the Legislature of Bechuanaland.

Short Title

1. This Law may be cited as the Final Appropriation (1964/65) Law, 1966.

Public Funds Charged with a Further Sum of R5,778.

2. The public funds of Bechuanaland are hereby charged with a further sum of R5,778 (five thousand seven hundred and seventy-eight rand) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year which ended on the 31st day of March, 1965, in excess of the amount appropriated for the services of that year, according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule to this Law.
