A LAW TO AMEND THE NURSES AND MIDWIVES LAW, 1964

[By notice under Section 1]

ENACTED by the Legislature of Bechuanaland.

Short Title and Commencement.

1. This Law may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives (Amendment) Law, 1966, and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by Her Majesty's Commissioner by notice in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of Section 2 of Law No. 43 of 1964.

2. Section 2 of the Nurses and Midwives Law, 1964, is amended by the deletion of the definition "Ministers" and by the substitution of the following definition—

"Ministers" means —

- (a) the Minister of the Basutoland Government for the time being responsible for Health ;
- (b) the Member of the Executive Council for Swaziland or Minister of the Swaziland Government for the time being associated with or responsible for medical services ; and
- (c) the Minister;".
