**BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE (CONSTITUTION)
ORDER, 1965**

**THE CONTROL OF PUBLIC SERVICE (DELEGATION OF
POWERS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1966**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 78 (2) of the Constitution of Bechuanaland (Schedule to the Bechuanaland Protectorate (Constitution) Order, 1965 (Legal Notice No. 1 of 1965)), His Excellency Her Majesty's Commissioner hereby makes the following regulations —

Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Control of Public Service (Delegation of Powers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1966.

Amendment of Regulation 2 of Legal Notice No. 42 of 1965.

2. Regulation 2 of the Control of Public Service (Delegation of Powers) Regulations, 1965 published in Legal Notice No. 42 of 1965, (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) is amended by the insertion immediately after the definition "responsible officer" of the following definition —

"Unit" means the Water and Electricity Unit of the Bechuanaland Government."

Amendment to Regulation 3 of the Schedule to Legal Notice No. 42 of 1965.

3. Regulation 3 of the Schedule to the principal regulations is amended at the end of paragraph (c) by the deletion of the full stop and by the substitution of a semi-colon and by the addition of the following paragraph —

"(d) Offices in the Water and Electricity Unit."

Insertion of Paragraph 4A in the Schedule to Legal Notice No. 42 of 1965.

4. The principal regulations are amended in the Schedule by the insertion immediately after paragraph 4 of the following paragraph —

"4A Power to appoint, transfer, terminate the appointment of, dismissal and exercise of disciplinary control over non-established officers in the Water and Electricity Unit is hereby delegated to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Works and Communications."
