**NOTICE OF TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR IN THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENT (DISTRICT COUNCILS) LAW, 1965**

It is hereby notified for general information that the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965 (Law No. 35 of 1965), as passed by the Legislative Assembly and assented to by His Excellency Her Majesty's Commissioner, contained section 31 which was omitted from the Law as published in the Supplement to the Gazette dated 31st December, 1965.

2. The Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965 (No. 35 of 1965) as published in the said supplement shall accordingly be read as if section 31, which is set out in the Schedule hereto, had been published therewith.

SCHEDULE

Power to Make By-Laws.

31. (1) A council may make by-laws for the area in respect of which it has been established, or any part thereof, in respect of all such matters as it considers necessary or desirable for the maintenance of the health, safety and well-being of the inhabitants of such area or such part; and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, may make by-laws for all or any of the purposes set out in the Schedule.

(2) Such by-laws may prescribe what licences or permits may be required thereunder, and may lay down the fees to be paid therefor, and may also prescribe the fees to be paid for any services to be rendered by the council.

(3) Any by-law may require acts or things to be performed or done to the satisfaction of a prescribed person, and may empower a prescribed person to issue directions to any other person requiring acts or things to be done, imposing conditions and prescribing periods within or before which such acts or things shall be performed or done or such conditions shall be fulfilled.
