**THE TOWNSHIPS PROCLAMATION (CAP. 120)**

**DECLARATION OF TOWNSHIPS**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Cap. 120), His Excellency Her Majesty's Commissioner hereby directs that items 2 and 4 of the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 27 of 1960 be deleted and replaced with the following new items —

**2. GABERONES TOWNSHIP**

The boundary of the township is as follows:

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the Railway Strip No. 16-KO on the prolongation of the northern boundary of Lot 1 Gaberones represented on diagram S.G. No. 36/63 by the line B - A the boundary runs eastwards in a straight line through the beacons lettered "A" and "B" on the said diagram S.G. No. 36/63 to the point in the middle of the Notwani River lettered "b" on the said diagram S.G. No. 36/63; thence generally southwestwards following the middle of the said Notwani River to the point in the middle of the said Notwani River lettered "a" on diagram S.G. No. 6/65 of Portion 1 of Kentholme No. 13-KO; thence following the boundaries of the said portion 1 of Kentholme No. 13-KO through the beacons lettered "A", "B", "C", "D", "E" and "F" on the said diagram S.G. No. 6/65; thence following the boundaries of Portion 1 of Werribee No. 12-KO through the beacons lettered "B", "C", "D", "E" and "F" on diagram S.G. No. 5/65 of the said Portion 1 of Werribee No. 12-KO; thence following the boundaries of Portion 1 of Atholl Holme No. 11-KO through the beacons lettered "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "G", "H", "J", "K", "L" and "M" on diagram S.G. No. 4/65 of the said Portion 1 of Atholl Holme No. 11-KO to the point in the middle of the said Notwani River lettered "m" on the said diagram S.G. 4/65; thence generally southwestwards following the middle of the said Notwani River to its confluence with the Metsimatswaane River; thence generally westwards along the middle of the said Metsimatswaane River to its point of intersection with the western fence of the railway strip through the Remainder of the farm Forest Hill No 9-KO; thence generally northeastwards along the said western fence of the said railway strip to the beacon lettered "a" on diagram S.G. No. A230/1921 of Portion 2 (a portion of Portion 1) of the farm Forest Hill No. 9-KO; thence continuing generally northeastwards along the western boundary of the said Portion 2 (a portion of Portion 1) of the farm Forest Hill No. 9-KO and the eastern boundary of the farm Bonnington No. 7-KO through the beacons lettered "p", "k", "j", "i", "h", "g", "f", "e", "d", "c"

and "b" on diagram S.G. No. A.942/1914 of the said farm Bonnington No. 7-KO; thence continuing northeastwards along the western boundary of the said Railway Strip No. 16-K0 to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan KO-113 filed in the Department of the Surveyor-General.

#### 4. LOBATSI TOWNSHIP

The boundary of the township is as follows:

Commencing at the northwestern beacon of Lot 1 Lobatsi lettered "d" on diagram S.G. No. A.216/29 of the said Lot 1 Lobatsi the boundary runs generally southeastwards along the northern boundaries of the said Lot 1 Lobatsi to the beacon lettered "F" on the said diagram S. G. No. A.216/29 being a beacon on the western boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7-JO; thence northeastwards in a straight line to the beacon lettered "T8" on diagram S.G. No. 8125/59 of the said Railway Reserve No. 7-JO to the beacon lettered "A" on diagram S.G. No. B.788/1926 of the farm Woodhall No. 11-JO; thence generally southeastwards along the eastern boundaries of the farm Woodhall No. 11-JO and the farm Pumula No. 20-JO to the beacon lettered "C" on diagram S.G. No. 334/1915 of the said farm Pumula No. 20-JO; thence along the southeastern southern and western boundaries of the said farm Pumula No. 20-JO to the beacon lettered "H" on the said diagram S.G. No. 334/1915; thence continuing northwestwards along the western boundaries of the farm Readfontein No. 19-JO to the beacon lettered "a" on diagram S.G. No. 3266/55 of Lot 342 Lobatsi; thence through the beacon lettered "b" to the beacon lettered "c" on the said diagram S.G. No. 3266/55; thence southwards along the eastern boundaries of Lot 333 Lobatsi, Lot 620 Lobatsi and Lot 330 Lobatsi; thence generally southwestwards along the southeastern boundaries of Lot 330 Lobatsi, Lot 620 Lobatsi and Lot 329 Lobatsi to the beacon lettered "d" on diagram S.G. No. A4538/1929 of the said Lot 329 Lobatsi; thence northwestwards in a straight line to a beacon lettered "Q" on the diagram S.G. No. 4820/59 of Lot 322 Lobatsi; thence northwestwards in a straight line to the beacon lettered "R" on the said diagram No. 4820/59; thence generally north northwestwards along the eastern boundaries of the farm Nootgedacht No. 13-JO to the beacon lettered "C" on diagram S.G. No. 19/1911 of the said farm Nootgedacht No. 13-JO and lettered "A2" on the said diagram S.G. No. A.216/29 of the said Lot 1 Lobatsi; thence westwards and northwards along the southern and western boundaries of the said Lot 1 Lobatsi to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan JO-107 filed in the Department of the Surveyor-General.
