**AN ACT TO AMEND THE BOTSWANA TEACHING SERVICE LAW, 1964, BY
PRESCRIBING A COMPULSORY RETIRING AGE FOR TEACHERS**

Date of Assent: 30.12.68.

Date of Commencement: 31.12.68.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Botswana Teaching Service Law (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Substitution of Section 15 of Law 35 of 1964

2. The Botswana Teaching Service Law, 1964, is amended by the repeal of section 15 and the substitution of —

“Retirement

15. (1) The Director may require an employer to terminate the appointment of a teacher if in the opinion of the Director the teacher has become incapable of discharging his duties adequately by reason of any infirmity of mind or body which a medical practitioner has certified is likely to be permanent or to continue for more than six months.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sections 13 and 14, any teacher whose appointment has not otherwise been terminated shall retire on attaining the age of 65 years.”
