AN ACT TO AMEND THE COMMONWEALTH COUNTRIES ACT, 1968.

Date of Assent: 6.9.68

Date of Commencement: 13.9.68

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Commonwealth Countries (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 1 of Act No. 5 of 1968

2. Section 1 of the Commonwealth Countries Act, 1968, is amended by the insertion after "section 3" of "and in subsection (1) of section 4".

Addition of Section 4 to Act No. 5 of 1968

3. The Commonwealth Countries Act, 1968, is amended by the addition of the following section —

"Section 28 of the Constitution to apply to Swaziland

4. (1) This section shall come into operation on a date to be appointed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.

(2) Swaziland shall be a country to which section 28 of the Constitution applies."
