AN ACT TO AMEND FURTHER THE COMPANIES PROCLAMATION, 1959

Date of Assent: 24.4.68.

Date of Commencement: 26.4.68.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Companies (Further Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 94(1) of Proclamation No. 71 of 1959

2. The Companies Proclamation, 1959, is amended in section 94 by the deletion of subsection (1) and the substitution of –

“(1) A company may, if so authorised by its articles, cause to be kept in any external country a register (in this Proclamation called a branch register) of members resident in that or any other external country.”.

Passed by the National Assembly this day, the 5th April, 1968.
