

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL PROVISIONS
LAW, 1966**

Date of Assent: 27.2.68.

Date of Commencement: 1.3.68.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Interpretation and General Provisions (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 3 of Law No. 13 of 1966

2. Section 3 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Law, 1966, is amended —

- (a) in the definition of "Botswana" by the addition of "or in relation to any occurrence, matter or thing prior to 30th September, 1966, means the Bechuanaland Protectorate;" ;
- (b) in the definition of "Chapter", "Part", "regulation", "rule", "Schedule", and "section" by the insertion after "paragraph" of "sub-paragraph" and the insertion after "paragraph" of "or sub-paragraph" ;
- (c) in the definition of "Permanent Secretary" by the addition of "and includes the Secretary to the Cabinet".
