**AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROMISSORY OATHS LAW, 1966, TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION RELATING TO THE CABINET OATH**

Date of Assent: 6.9.68

Date of Commencement: 13.9.68

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**Short Title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Promissory Oaths (Amendment) Act, 1968.

**Substitution of Section 3 of Law No. 36 of 1966**

2. The Promissory Oaths Law, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended by the repeal of section 3 and the substitution of —

**“President May Require Oath of Allegiance or Cabinet Oath to be Taken**

3. (1) The President may require any public officer to take and subscribe the oath of allegiance and may require any person attending a meeting of the Cabinet to take and subscribe the Cabinet oath.

(2) Such oaths shall be in the forms set out in the Second Schedule and shall be tendered by and subscribed before a person designated by the President.”.

**Amendment of Second Schedule of Law No. 36 of 1966**

3. The principal law is amended in the Second Schedule in the form prescribed for the Cabinet Oath by the deletion of “having been appointed to the office of .....
