**Short Title**

1. This Act may be cited as the State Land (Amendment) Act, 1968.

**Amendment of Section 2 of Law No. 29 of 1966**

2. Section 2 of the State Land Law, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended —

- (a) in the definition of "state land" by the addition of "and includes any land outside Botswana ownership whereof is vested in the Republic";
- (b) in the definition of "reacquired state land" by the insertion after "any land" of "in Botswana".

**Amendment of Section 7 of Law No. 29 of 1966**

3. Section 7 of the principal law is amended —

- (a) by inserting the following headnote "Disposal Of Proceeds of Sales of State Land"; and

(b) in subsection (1) by the insertion after "sales of all" of "unalienated state land and reacquired";

(c) by adding the following subsection —

"(3) All other proceeds of the sales of state land shall be paid into the Land Sales Fund established under section 10(7) of the Finance and Audit Law, 1965 (No. 15 of 1965) and shall be withdrawn only in such amounts and for such purposes as the National Assembly may from time to time approve by resolution:

Provided that the provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any fee which the purchaser has contracted to pay as a consideration for the survey, development or conveyance to him of such land."
