**AN ACT TO AMEND THE SUBORDINATE COURTS PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 5)**

Date of Assent: 27.2.68.

Date of Commencement: On a date to be appointed.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**Short Title and Commencement**

1. This Act may be cited as the Subordinate Courts (Amendment) Act, 1968, and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

**Amendment of Section 2 of Chapter 5**

2. The Subordinate Courts Proclamation (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended in section 2 by the deletion of the definition of "District" and the substitution of -

""District" means one of the several areas prescribed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette* "as districts" for the purposes of this Proclamation; and in relation to any Subordinate Court means the area within which that court has jurisdiction;".

**Amendment of Section 5 of Chapter 5**

3. The principal law is amended in section 5 by the deletion of the proviso thereto.

**Amendment of Section 70 of Chapter 5**

4. The principal law is amended in section 70 -

(a) by the deletion of "the court of" wherever it appears and the substitution of "a court having jurisdiction within";

(b) in subsection (6) by the deletion of "of any" and the substitution of "in any".
